STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Llano County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Llano County, that the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) -Mitigation Projects be operated for the 2026-2027; and

WHEREAS, Llano County Commissioners Court agrees to provide 30 percent for the said project as required by the Public Safety Office (PSO) grant application; and


WHEREAS, The Llano County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the Llano County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The Llano County Commissioners Court designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, The Llano County Commissioners Court designates County Auditor as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Llano County Commissioners Court approves submission of the grant application for the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) -Mitigation Projects (Name of Project) to the Office of the Governor.






