

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into between Blanco County, Texas (Blanco) and Llano County (Llano), collectively referred to herein as the “Parties.”

- I. **Purpose:** The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) agreed to station more regular patrol units in Blanco and Llano if the Counties agreed to pay for space to house a supervisor and to provide one dedicated administrative support staff member. Having more patrol units in Blanco and Llano would be beneficial for the citizens of both counties.
- II. **Term:** This MOU starts on October 1, 2025 and shall continue through September 30, 2026. This MOU shall renew on an annual basis thereafter unless either party terminates this MOU.
- III. **Termination:** Either party may terminate this MOU providing at least 60 days written notice of termination on or before October 1 of the then current fiscal year. Notice of termination only terminates the party’s obligation for the next fiscal year but does not relieve the party of its obligations for the then current fiscal year.
- IV. **Amendments:** Any change to this MOU must be in writing.
- V. **Responsibilities:**
  - A. **Blanco agrees to:**
    1. Provide and pay for an office space in Johnson City, Texas which is intended to support DPS Troopers assigned to Blanco and Llano Counties.
    2. Hire one support staff member who would be assigned solely to the Johnson City DPS office (hereinafter the DPS Support Staff). The Support Staff shall be a Blanco County employee but will be assigned solely to the Johnson City DPS office.
    3. Pay the costs associated with the office space, including rent and utilities, and pay one-half of the salary and benefits of the Support Staff.
    4. Invoice Llano for the items outlined below.
  - B. **Llano agrees to:**
    1. Reimburse Blanco for one-half (50%) of the salary and benefits of the DPS Support Staff member. Invoices shall be paid within 30 days of receipt of the invoice from Blanco.
- VI. Estimate of Costs
  - A. For budget year 2025-2026, the salary and benefits for the Support Staff is:  
FY25-26 = \$76,393    ½ = \$38,196.50
  - B. Salary and benefits may increase annually. Blanco County shall provide notice of anticipated salary and benefits increases for the Support Staff no later than August 1 of each budget year.


