

# A PROCLAMATION AUTHORIZING RECOGNITION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WEEK

**WHEREAS**, the week of April 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026 has been designated as National Community Development Week by the National Community Development Association (NCDCA) to recognize the impact of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program in strengthening communities across the nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Block Grant Program, established through the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, helps communities address critical needs such as public infrastructure, economic development, housing, and services benefiting low- and moderate-income individuals and families; and


**WHEREAS**, in Texas, CDBG funding is administered through the Texas Department of Agriculture's Texas Community Development Block Grant (TxCDBG) Program, which supports infrastructure and community development projects in rural and smaller communities across the state; and

**WHEREAS**, communities across the Capital Area Council of Governments (CAPCOG) region have utilized TxCDBG funding to improve water and wastewater systems, sidewalks and other public infrastructure, and economic development opportunities that strengthen the health, safety, and quality of life for residents; and


