RE: County Wide Voting

Dear Ms Wilson:

First, let me offer my gratitude and my congratulations on a job well done in managing Llano County's elections. The residents of Llano County have been well served by your enthusiasm and demonstrated competence.

Second, I want to commend and support your efforts to improve the voting system in Llano County by instituting County Wide Voting. Based on my recent experience assisting with elections, I can see that such a change would benefit a great many voters in the County and particularly in Precinct 101, where I have been serving as Election Judge.

During early voting, voters may choose to vote at any available polling place; many choose to do so at the Llano Library which is in a central location and readily accessible to all in the County. However, on election day, each voter is restricted to voting specifically in his/her precinct, which has on many occasions has proven to be confusing to many voters. In Precinct 101 on election day, it is common for voters come in to vote saying that they have mistakenly attempted to vote at the Llano Library but were informed that they must go to the actual Precinct location. On the other hand, multiple voters enter the Precinct 101 location to vote but learn at the last minute that they must travel to another distant polling location to cast their vote. In at least one instance, a couple came to Precinct 101 to cast their vote, only to learn that they were required to travel some distance to the eastern portion of the County to vote; because of the late hour, they were unable to do so and were unable to cast their vote.

For Precinct 101 at least, voting locations placed near the southern and/or eastern portions of the precinct (or access to existing locations) would shorten the travel time to and from voting places and result in a tremendous convenience for voters.

Since I have been serving as Election Judge for Precinct 101 for several years, several issues have surfaced:

1. Precinct 101 has very few voters (slightly over 300) in comparison to other precincts; however, on election day it is common for only 12 voters to vote at the actual Precinct 101

polling location. On major elections, the number of voters at Precinct 101 will be between 30 and 40.


2. The majority of Precinct 101 voters choose to vote early at the Llano Library, which is a short drive (2-1/4 miles) from the official Precinct 101 polling location.
3. Even though relatively few voters choose to use the Precinct 101 location, Llano County is still obligated to provide a full staff of election workers and equipment to maintain and operate the polling place. In all fairness, this represents a highly inefficient use of County resources and manpower.

I believe that a shift to County Wide voting would facilitate removing, replacing, or relocating the current polling location for Precinct 101, would serve to benefit Precinct 101 voters, and provide a significant savings to Llano County. There may be other such efficiencies to be gained in other precincts.

I understand that much thought and careful planning will be required to bring about the change to County Wide voting without creating new inconveniences; however, I am confident that with sufficient effort, the change may be instituted such that there will be a net benefit to Llano County voters.

My name is Carlton Johnson and I have worked as a poll worker since 2022 and on election days we are constantly turning people away. Because they are not at their designated precinct for Voting. Election day 2025 I was called into work the last four hours and we turned away 25 couples husband and wife. They were used to voting during early hours and were completely unaware that they had to vote in their own precinct. That amounts to 50 votes that may or may not have been cast that day. We had to look the individuals up in the poll pad to pull up their pulling voting location, give them directions in many cases. We have completely inconvenienced the voter because we basically programmed them to vote at certain locations due to early voting. So they are unaware until they arrive on election date that they cannot vote at that location.

I'm all for this change regarding the inclusion in the Texas Secretary State of Countywide polling place program in Llano County.

Support for county-wide voting



Dear Andrea Wilson,

I am in favor of county wide voting. Having worked elections as both a poll worker and election judge since 2022, I have heard many positive comments about the flexibility and convenience of county wide voting during early voting. A majority of the comments are the following: "I was headed to the store, the school, the gym, or the gas station and stopped by to vote." Also, "this location is closer than my election day precinct polling location, and it lets me vote before/after I get off work. I pass several other polling locations on my way home from work. This location takes away the time crunch of reaching the poll before it closes." These comments show the flexibility needed by our voting public.

The current system of mandatory voting in a single assigned location on election day creates extra time and transportation burdens on the voter. During each election day, we have multiple people arrive and state that they are not sure if this location is where they are supposed to vote today. Many have been to another polling site and directed to the correct voting location. The closest location they were directed from is a minimum of 5.8 miles away. It can be up to 20 miles away. Llano County covers 941 square miles. By having county wide voting, these disruptions in the voting process will be reduced or even eliminated.

To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of the City Council of the City of Sunrise Beach Village, Llano, we are writing to express our support for legislation that would allow counties to implement countywide voting on Election Day. Countywide voting provides a more accessible and convenient voting experience for residents by allowing voters to cast their ballots at any polling location within the county, rather than being restricted to a single precinct. This flexibility is especially beneficial in rural communities such as Llano County, where travel distances and scheduling constraints can present challenges for voters.

The Llano County Voting Advisory Committee has met on two occasions to evaluate the feasibility and effectiveness of implementing countywide voting. As part of this process, the committee conducted inspections of polling locations throughout the county and carefully considered which sites would best serve the public.

Based on these evaluations, the committee recommended not opening polling locations in Tow, Blue Lake, and the County Office on East State Highway 71 for Election Day. In contrast, the committee identified Precinct 4 courtroom as a beneficial addition. Along with keeping the City of Sunrise Beach, City of Horseshoe Bay, East Llano Annex, Lakeshore Library, Kingsland Library, Llano Library on Election Day polling location to better serve voters.

We believe these thoughtful recommendations, combined with the flexibility of countywide voting, will enhance voter participation, improve accessibility, and create a more efficient election process for the citizens of Llano County. The City of Sunrise Beach Village City Council respectfully supports this legislation and encourages its adoption to better serve our community.
