NEW- JP4 Courtroom

These recommendations are based on the requirement that no Commissioner's Precinct would have more than 50% more vote centers than another commissioner's precinct. We would move the Llano Agri-Life polling location (pct1) to the JP4 Courtroom (pct4) to ensure there are still 2 locations for voters on the western half of the county, and eliminate 1 polling location each in pct 2 and 4 to maintain the 50% ratio required by statute.

The Vote Center Advisory Committee looked at a variety of factors in making their determination for which locations to eliminate, including but not limited to the locations capacity and ability to take on more equipment, proximity to through traffic, and compliance with the ADA requirements for polling locations.

The full **Methodology Criteria** are the 5 items listed here:

ADA Accessibility

Election Day Turnout

Capacity

Distance to next polling location

Connectivity
