WHEREAS, Pursuant to Election Code §43.007 et. seq., Texas counties may submit an application to the Texas Secretary of State to participate in a program to use countywide polling places for elections as an alternative to having polling places located in each county election precinct;







Dear Ms. Adkins,

Llano County formally submits a request to participate in the County Wide Polling Place Program and has taken the necessary actions to do so.

On April 14, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., the Llano County Commissioner's Court held a public hearing regarding applying for the County Wide Polling Place Program. Pursuant to the Election Code, notice of the public hearing was posted in the local newspaper. All political subdivisions, party chairs, representatives of voters with disabilities, and minority leaders were given notice of this meeting. Public input at the meeting was unanimously in favor of participating in the program.

Following the hearing, Commissioner's Court voted to accept the Vote Center Advisory Committees' recommendations for Election Day Vote Centers and passed a resolution in support of applying for participation in the Texas Countywide Polling Place Program in Llano County. A recording of the hearing is included with the submission of this letter.
