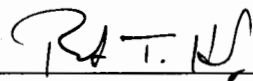
WHEREAS, his service has contributed significantly to the effective operation of county government, ensuring that the interests of the public were represented with diligence, fairness, and wisdom; and

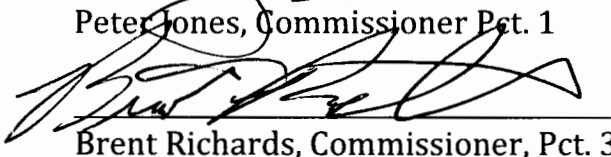

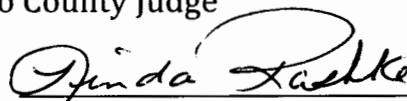

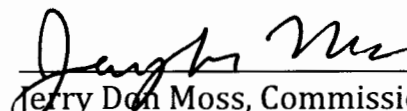
Peter Jones, Commissioner Pct. 1



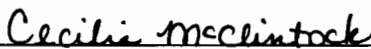
